- Median fraud loss is \$150,000

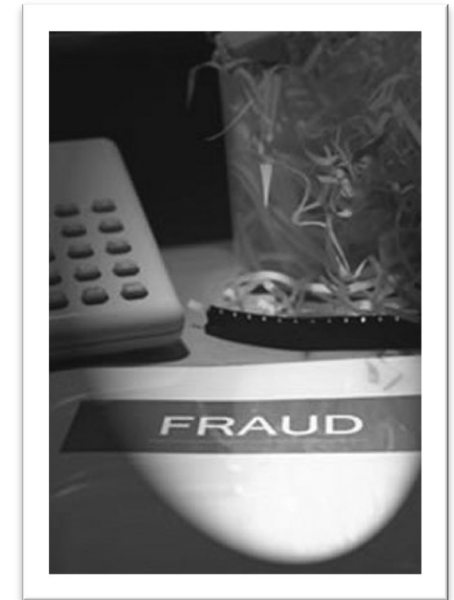

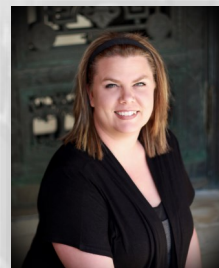
